Nicole Meurée-Vanlaethem graduated as a Ph D in Electrochemistry at the Brussels Free University. After some years spent in fundamental research, she joined the control laboratory of the Belgian Ministry of Economics where she later participated in the development of accreditation in Belgium. Since 1994, she has been successively responsible for the accreditation of testing and medical laboratories, quality manager and finally director of BELAC, the Belgian accreditation body, a position that she has held until December 2015. She is now acting as Training Manager and is still in charge of international relations between BELAC and the internal associations of accreditation bodies, namely EA, ILAC and IAF.
